

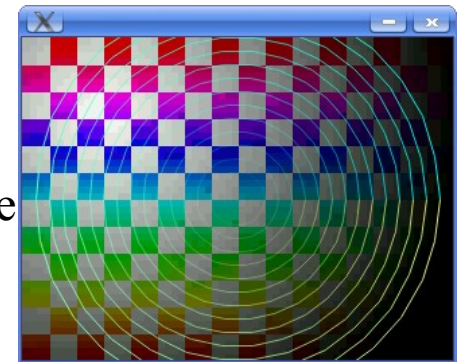

The **CRT X-Y Library** is allows programmers to duplicate the look and feel of classic “vector-based” arcade games of the late 1970s and early 1980s. It's meant to let the end-user decide the level of detail – and even display size – of games, rather than leaving it up to the programmer. This encourages games which can scale down to embedded systems, such as the GP2X handheld game system, the Apple iPhone and Nokia's Linux-based internet tablets.



Bill Kendrick is an open source software developer, and creator of two dozen games for Linux, Windows, Mac OS X and other platforms, including “Vectoroids,” an Asteroids homage.
