

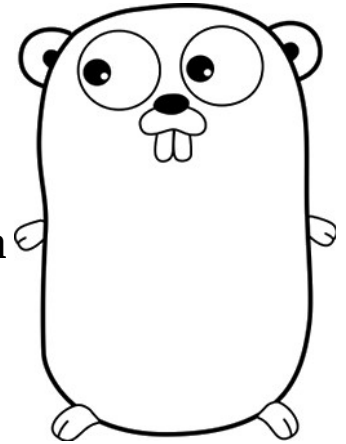

Go is a new programming language created in 2006 by Google. It's released as open source software for Linux, Mac Os X, Windows and more. While originally envisioned as a modern alternative to static languages such as *C++* and *Java*, it has found a steady following in refugees from dynamic languages such as *Ruby* and *Python* due to its simple, consistent, and performant design.



This presentation will go over some of the basic concepts of *Go* such as build structure, error handling, tag annotation, and the power of interfaces while making a simple web application.
